- Discussing techniques, approaches, and strategies for thinking critically about effective Education for Sustainable Development and Global Citizenship (ESDGC).
- Reflecting on participants’ own training practice and discussing / sharing practical ways in which to deliver training on Sustainable Development and Global Citizenship.
